This event is designed to start or complete a merit badge; however it will not be a "Merit Badge Giveaway". Each Scout is expected to earn the merit badge.

Remember that you must have your Scoutmaster approve any badge you intend to work on. Each Scout is expected to provide:

- Signed Merit Badge cards
- Updated Merit Badge books/worksheets
- Writing Materials

Scouts will be expected to arrive **in uniform** and have their (blue) merit badge cards signed by their scout leaders.

For your convenience, Jamboree Troop 830 will be providing a food concessions booth for you to purchase drinks, snacks, and various food items. Thank you for joining us in our Midway efforts. We hope you will enjoy yourself, and take full advantage of the opportunities provided for you.

Sylmar High School is located in the foothills of the northeast San Fernando Valley in the city of Sylmar, just south of the 210.



From the North:

Take the 5 South to the 210 East and exit Polk St. Turn right onto Polk St. Go 2-3 blocks and turn left onto Borden St.

From the South:

Take the 405 North or 5 South to the 210 East and exit Polk St. Turn right onto Polk St. Go 2-3 blocks and turn left onto Borden St.

From the East:

Take the 210 West and exit Polk St. Turn left onto Polk St. Go 2-3 blocks and turn left onto Borden St.

Merit Badge Instructions

General Instructions:

Please download and complete as much as possible the merit badge worksheets for any merit badge being worked on. Be prepared to discuss what you have written down. Prerequisites for each merit badge follow if you wish to earn the merit badge at the midway, or a follow-up meeting can be scheduled to complete the merit badge.

Family Life: Requirement #3, #4, #5, #6 - Please complete and have parent provide a note to document.

Communications: Requirement #1a or b if you choose, or c or d can be done in class, #4, #5, #6-come prepared with teaching aids, #7,#8, Please complete and have parent/teacher/adult provide a note to document.

First Aid: Bring worksheets and handbook if at all possible. You must be present the WHOLE day to receive credit.

Reading: #1d – Bring reading logs. #2 – be prepared to discuss this with me. #4 – Tell me about your community service

Computers: #6 – Bring documentation about the 3 items you did. #7 – Bring documentation. #10 – Discuss the careers with me.

Citizenship in the World: #3 – Bring worksheets to discuss issue and country. #7 – bring documentation for the two items you completed.

Citizenship in the Community: Requirements 3, 4, 5, 7 & 8. Scouts will need to provide the following on their worksheets as verification: Req. 3A - Date and type of meeting attended; 3B - A brief written paragraph about on worksheet; Req. 4ABC - A copy of your interview (in letter or summary format) with the person in government you interviewed. Req. 5 - Title of movie, the dated viewed and a summary of what you learned from the movie. Req. 7ABC – Date/Hours of Volunteer work (must total minimum of 8 hours) Be prepared to discuss the organization you volunteered for. Req. 8 – Public Presentation (Be prepared to present at Merit Badge midway)

Photography: Req. 4A OR 4B – Be prepared to present your photographs at the midway as outlined in your Merit Badge book. Strongly encouraged to bring your camera (ready to use) with you to Midway.

Scholarship: Requirement 1: Need to bring your report card(s), Requirement 3: Need to bring a note from principal

Sports: Bring documentation on training activities, team participation, & worksheets

Signoffs: Any class designated as a signoff is intended to assist scouts complete merit badges that were partially completed at summer camp or during the year.
